RE: Library System Area and Per Capita Grant Funding – FY08

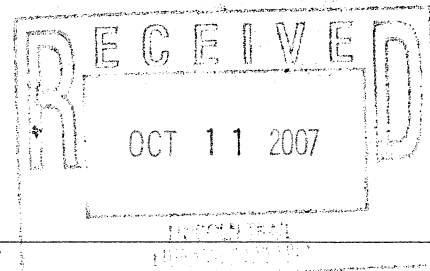
Pursuant to Public Act 95-0348 and 75 ILCS 10/8(c), the Illinois State Library has calculated the annual Area and Per Capita Grant funding for each of the library systems. Allocations are based upon \$1.2682 per person residing within and \$47.4326 per square mile of each library system. This is the same funding level that you received in FY07.

Grant payments shall be made upon the availability of funds within the State Treasury. There shall be seven payments issued to each library system. Please share this information with your business office personnel so that payments can be tracked appropriately. Attached is a spreadsheet that illustrates the individual payment amounts.

Here is the allocation total for each library system:

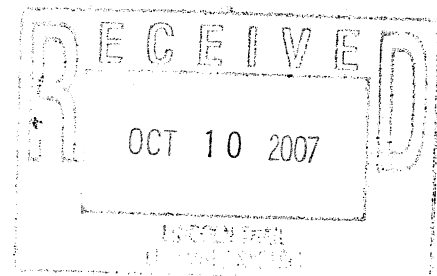
